Alma Carmona-Alday discussed the following: Enrollment is lower than any other year, but fortunately we will be keeping all current staff. School Board Member, Ms. Eckstrom visited on 8/2624 and was very impressed with our school (discussed lack of music, fencing on north playground and school bond committee) but there are other schools without or in need of A/C and roof issues which are the priority. A Title 1 walk-through will take place 8/30/24 to look for instructional practices/strategies that are being implemented. There will be a presentation spotlighting our school on 9/4/24 from TNTP to share the results from a study that began 3 years ago with Van Buskirk that focused on the last ten years (minus 2 years of COVID) and how students upon leaving our school are at or above grade level up to 1 ½ years ahead in comparison with other schools across the United States. Lastly, on 9/9/24 District administrators will be coming to share our letter grade based on AASA results. d. Will be on 9/18/24-9/20-24 for parents and teachers to discuss how their children/students are doing. e. Book Fair will be held from 9/16/24-9/20/24 in the library. Picture Day is scheduled for 9/9/24 and Benchmark Testing is around the corner.

ITEM TITLE	3 Mariachi Student Leaders: \$5,400 from Undesignated Tax Credit

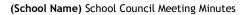
ITEM TITLE	Uniforms and instruments for Mariachi
