DISCUSSION	a. Alma Carmona-Alday shared that 5 <sup>th</sup> and 8 <sup>th</sup> grade students began the AZ Science Test today and will be finished by the end of the week (3/21), and the importance of this test because the outcome is one of the factors that determines our school letter grade and how a school is designated for School Improvement. She also shared that next week (3/24-3/28) will be a by-week giving us another week to prepare for AASA and we will be having Kick Off assemblies on Friday (3/28) for 3 <sup>rd</sup> -4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> -6 <sup>th</sup> , and 7 <sup>th</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> with skits by staff. All PLC's will be cancelled for the 3 weeks of AASA testing. On March 25 <sup>th</sup> we will



	be having a Family Math Night & Registration Event, and we are in need of teachers (will receive a flex pass) to attend, and share take home activities for students and parents; PTSA will be providing hot-dogs and other Community organizations will be providing information (Public Library, etc.) for families. We will also be holding a Community Yard Sale hosted by our PTSA with spots available for \$15 on Saturday, March 22. The following weekend 3/29 we will be hosting Market on the Move where the community can by 60 lbs. of produce for \$10. Next week on March 26 <sup>th</sup> there will be no school for students because it is the last District PLD for all staff. Our Jump Party will be held the last Friday in April after AASA and if weather permits. May will be busy as well; Teacher Appreciation Week (May 5 <sup>th</sup> -9 <sup>th</sup> ), Junior Achievement Day on May 6 <sup>th</sup> (where community members volunteer and teach our students, while the classroom Teacher supports and supervises the students in their classrooms), Volunteer Breakfast, Wildcat Walk (8 <sup>th</sup> graders walk through school for the last time while the whole school cheers and celebrates this accomplishment), Field Day on May 16 <sup>th</sup> , 8 <sup>th</sup> grade promotion on May 20 <sup>th</sup> .  b.
