Open House on 8/20/25 many community members will be on campus to share services. 6. AVID roll-out will begin with assemblies on 8/8/25 and more teachers



	will attend training. 7. Project Momentum is underway since we are under school improvement due to State Testing requirements and our students' w/disabilities (21.99) not meeting proficiency for 2 years consecutively. We have set goals for student engagement and Math (critical reading strategies to help breakdown problems). Ms. Maldonado, our new Math interventionist, will work with Ex-Ed and Cusp students. 8. Teachers who were in the top 25% for ELA and Math for our district on State Testing were recognized. 9. Pueblo HS has an Academy, and we will have a Pre-Academy this year for 6 th -8 th grade students offering dual credit or accelerated classes (students must have a C or better, 15 hrs. of community service, 5 absences or less and complete a capstone project). 8 th graders will also have the opportunity to be in guitar, piano, theater or folklorico during 1 st period. 10. 21 st Century will continue, but at this time are awaiting more information because funding had been withheld. 11.
