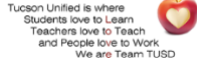

Dear CE Rose Families,

Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! I want to WELCOME all current and new students and families to C.E. Rose PreK-8! It's a great place to be! Thank you for choosing our school for your child/ren. We can't wait to get started and we are preparing for them to come to school. Here is some information about our school:

- 1. School starts @ 8:25 am**
 - a. TBA (to be announced): Morning Supervision and Covid safety protocols
- 2. School ends for K-6 at 2:40 pm (Mon., Tues., Thurs., Fri.).**
- 3. School ends for 7th and 8th at 3:40 pm (Mon., Tues., Thurs., Fri.)**
- 4. Wednesday dismissal for every grade is at 1:40 pm.**

"Governor Ducey signed HB2898. Included in this budget bill is a provision that prohibits counties, cities, towns, schools, and school districts from requiring students or staff to wear a face-covering during school hours and on school property, effective July 1, 2021. Therefore, TUSD's face-covering requirement should no longer be enforced for students or employees. They should be considered optional. Tucson Unified, along with federal, state, and local health officials, continue to recommend face coverings be worn by anyone who is not vaccinated. Please know that our district is working on a re-entry plan for this school year to ensure the health and safety of your child/ren. As we receive this information after the Governing Boarding meeting, we will inform parents through email and parentlink (please listen to all TUSD phone messages:225-6100)."

It is very important that your child(ren) arrive to school on time every day. Tardiness has a negative impact on their learning. Please see enclosed information from TUSD on how attendance and office procedures are followed for tardiness and absences required by A.R.S. (Arizona Revised Statutes). Students that arrive after 8:30 am should be accompanied by an adult to sign in. Your child will receive a late pass to class. If your child will be absent, please call Marie Huerta, School Registrar, at 908-4406 or Eunice Fierro, office assistant, at 908-4402.

Safety is always a priority at C.E. Rose PreK-8. Please remember that all doors to the school and gates will be locked during the school day. All parents, volunteers, and visitors must sign-in at the front office if they have a planned meeting or are volunteering.

We also ask that you please remember to use the appropriate drop off and pick up areas in front of the school. You may also park at the church in front of the school for extra parking. There is one entrance and one exit. We ask that you please stay in your vehicle and the teacher or staff member will get your child(ren) for you. Please follow all designated parking and no parking area signs. At dismissal all students will be escorted to the designated area.
